

FIVE KEYS FOR KNOWING GOD'S WILL

1. Through prayer, invite God to reveal His will to you.

- * *David's example in II Samuel 5:19*
- * Listen for His voice, as a response

2. God may speak to your situation through verses in the Bible.

- * *Psalm 119:133a*
- * Expose yourself to the Bible daily
so you can hear Him speak.

3. Watch for "open" or "closed" doors (positive, negative circumstances).

- * *Open and closed doors happened to Paul in Acts 13:2-3, 15, 44-45*
- * Thru good things or tough times:
"What is God trying to tell me?"

4. Use reason (but not reason alone) to think your situation through.

- * *Nehemiah's example in Nehemiah 4:11-16a*
- * Try a "pros and cons" list

5. Mature Christians can help us understand God's will better.

- * *Apollos was helped in Acts 18:26*
- * Talk to a pastor or trusted saint

God can make His will known to you through any one of these keys. But when all five keys fit together, you can be pretty sure that God has revealed His will to you.
