CHRIST'S DEATH AND RESURRECTION:

As we approach Easter, let's focus on Christ's Death and Resurrection:

During the Civil War, a farmer in New York was drafted for the Union army. His wife had died and he was the sole support of his young children. But then an unmarried man in the town who had no dependents came to his home and offered to go to war in the farmer's place. For the sake of his children, the farmer accepted the offer. The generous friend marched off to battle, and in the first engagement, he was shot and killed. When the farmer heard what had happened, he went to the scene of the battle and brought back the body. He buried his friend in the churchyard and had these words engraved on the headstone: HE DIED FOR ME.
